Senate Resolution

A resolution congratulating the Town of Davie on its induction into the National Park Service Certified Local Government Program.

WHEREAS, established by the National Park Service in 1980, the Certified Local Government Program is a federal, state, and local preservation partnership, and

WHEREAS, nationwide, there are about 2,000 certified local governments, each of which is committed to the protection of its unique historical, cultural, and archaeological resources for future generations, and

WHEREAS, the Town of Davie, located west of Fort Lauderdale in Broward County, was recently inducted into the Certified Local Government Program, making it the 80th local government in this state to achieve certification, and

WHEREAS, certification opens the door to training, technical assistance, and grant funds to further local preservation efforts, and

WHEREAS, the Town of Davie is working to conserve ancient ridge areas that include archaeological resources from American Indians, who were the first residents of the area, and to maintain its cultural ties to the past through its annual Orange Blossom Festival and its rodeo events and western-themed downtown area, NOW, THEREFORE,
