**Amendment (with title amendment)**

Remove lines 373-377 and insert:

6 (12) RULEMAKING.—The board may adopt rules to implement  
 7 this section. In addition, the board may adopt emergency rules,  
 8 pursuant to s. 120.54, at any time, as are necessary to  
 9 implement this section for the 2022-2023 fiscal year. The  
 10 Legislature finds that such emergency rulemaking power is  
 11 necessary in order to address a critical need in the state's  
 12 problematic property insurance market. The Legislature further  
 13 finds that the uniquely short time frame needed to effectively  
 14 implement this section for the 2022-2023 fiscal year requires  
 15 that the board adopt rules as quickly as practicable. Therefore,  
 16 in adopting such emergency rules, the board need not make the

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17 findings required by s. 120.54(4)(a). Emergency rules adopted  
18 under this section are exempt from s. 120.54(4)(c) and shall  
19 remain in effect until replaced by rules adopted under the  
20 nonemergency rulemaking procedures of chapter 120, which must  
21 occur no later than July 1, 2023.
