and insert:

(12) RULEMAKING.—The board may adopt rules to implement this section. In addition, the board may adopt emergency rules, pursuant to s. 120.54, at any time, as are necessary to implement this section for the 2022-2023 fiscal year. The Legislature finds that such emergency rulemaking power is necessary in order to address a critical need in the state's problematic property insurance market. The Legislature further



finds that the uniquely short timeframe needed to effectively 12 13 implement this section for the 2022-2023 fiscal year requires 14 that the board adopt rules as quickly as practicable. Therefore, 15 in adopting such emergency rules, the board need not make the 16 findings required by s. 120.54(4)(a). Emergency rules adopted 17 under this section are exempt from s. 120.54(4)(c) and shall 18 remain in effect until replaced by rules adopted under the 19 nonemergency rulemaking procedures of chapter 120, which must 2.0 occur no later than July 1, 2023. 21 22 ======== T I T L E A M E N D M E N T ========= 23 And the title is amended as follows: 24 Delete line 32 25 and insert: 2.6 requirements; authorizing the board to adopt 27 nonemergency rules and emergency rules; providing 28 legislative findings; specifying conditions and 29 limitations for any emergency rules adopted;
