9 1002.421 State school choice scholarship program 10 accountability and oversight.-

(1) PRIVATE SCHOOL ELIGIBILITY AND OBLIGATIONS.—A private school participating in an educational scholarship program established pursuant to this chapter must be a private school as defined in s. 1002.01(2) in this state, be registered, and be in compliance with all requirements of this section in addition to private school requirements outlined in s. 1002.42, specific 804115 - h0001-line 1210 Nixon.docx

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17 requirements identified within respective scholarship program 18 laws, and other provisions of Florida law that apply to private 19 schools, and must: 20 (a) Comply with the antidiscrimination provisions of 42

U.S.C. s. 2000d. In addition to the requirements of this 21 22 paragraph, a private school may not discriminate against a 23 student based on the student's race, color, national origin, sex, religion, disability, family status, birthplace, ancestry, 24 25 culture, language, sexual orientation, gender identity, or the expression or texture of the student's hair. A private school 26 27 that is found to have discriminated against a student is ineligible to receive state funds for a period of at least 3 28

29 <u>years</u>.

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31 The department shall suspend the payment of funds to a private 32 school that knowingly fails to comply with this subsection, and shall prohibit the school from enrolling new scholarship 33 students, for 1 fiscal year and until the school complies. If a 34 35 private school fails to meet the requirements of this subsection 36 or has consecutive years of material exceptions listed in the 37 report required under paragraph (q), the commissioner may 38 determine that the private school is ineligible to participate 39 in a scholarship program.
