 2           An act relating to specialty license plates; amending  
 3           s. 320.08058, F.S.; directing the Department of  
 4           Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles to develop an Ohio  
 5           State University license plate; providing for  
 6           distribution and use of fees collected from the sale  
 7           of the plate; providing an effective date.

9   Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

11           Section 1. Subsection (127) is added to section 320.08058,  
 12   Florida Statutes, to read:

13           320.08058 Specialty license plates.—

14           (127) OHIO STATE UNIVERSITY LICENSE PLATES.—

15           (a) The department shall develop an Ohio State University  
 16 license plate as provided in this section and s. 320.08053. The  
 17 plate must bear the colors and design approved by the  
 18 department. The word "Florida" must appear at the top of the  
 19 plate, and the word "Buckeyes" must appear at the bottom of the  
 20 plate.

21           (b) The annual use fees from the sale of the plate shall  
 22 be distributed annually as follows:

23           1. Up to 10 percent of the moneys raised from the sale of  
 24 the plate may be used for continuing marketing and promotion of  
 25 the plate by the Sarasota-Manatee Alumni Club.

26        2. In each school district that has a district  
27 prekindergarten through grade 12 public school foundation or a  
28 direct-support organization, the moneys raised in that school  
29 district through the sale of Ohio State University license  
30 plates must be distributed to the foundation or organization for  
31 enhancing educational programs.

32        3. In each school district that does not have a district  
33 prekindergarten through grade 12 public school foundation or a  
34 direct-support organization, the moneys raised in that school  
35 district through the sale of Ohio State University license  
36 plates must be distributed to the district school board and must  
37 be used at the discretion of the board for enhancing educational  
38 programs.

39        Section 2. This act shall take effect October 1, 2023.
