10 316.081 Driving on right side of roadway; exceptions.—

11 (4) On a road, street, or highway having two or more lanes
12 allowing movement in the same direction with a posted speed
13 limit of at least 65 miles per hour, a driver may not operate a

14 motor vehicle in the furthestmost left-hand lane, except when
 15 overtaking and passing another vehicle, when preparing to exit
 16 the road, street, or highway, or when otherwise directed by an
 17 official traffic control device. As used in this subsection, the
 18 term "furthestmost left-hand lane" means the farthest most left-
 19 hand lane, except that, if such left-hand lane is a high-
 20 occupancy-vehicle lane as defined in s. 316.0741 or is a
 21 designated left-hand turn lane, the furthestmost left-hand lane
 22 is the lane immediately to the right of such high-occupancy-
 23 vehicle lane or left-hand turn lane. This subsection does not
 24 apply to authorized emergency vehicles and vehicles engaged in
 25 highway maintenance or construction operations.

26 (6)-(5) A violation of this section is a noncriminal
 27 traffic infraction, punishable as a moving violation as provided
 28 in chapter 318.
