Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Section 124.012, Florida Statutes, is created to read:
124.012 Term limits of county commissioners.-
(1) A person may not appear on the ballot for reelection to the office of county commissioner if, by the end of his or her current term of office, the person will have served, or but for resignation would have served, in that office for 8 consecutive years. Service of a term of office which commenced before November 8, 2022, will not be counted toward the limitation imposed by this section.
(2) This section supersedes any term limits imposed by a county charter.

Section 2. Section 1001.35, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:
1001.35 Term of office.-District school board members shall be elected at the general election in November for terms of 4 years, except that a person may not appear on the ballot for reelection to the office of school board member if, by the end of his or her current term of office, the person will have served, or but for resignation would have served, in that office
