Remove everything after the enacting clause and insert:

7 Section 1. Present subsections (3), (4), and (5) of
 8 section 402.309, Florida Statutes, are redesignated as
 9 subsections (4), (5), and (6), respectively; subsection (2) is
 10 amended; and a new subsection (3) is added to that section, to
 11 read:

12 402.309 Provisional license or registration.—

13 (2) A provisional license or registration may not be issued
 14 unless the operator or owner makes adequate provisions for the
 15 health and safety of the child. ~~A provisional license may be~~
 16 ~~issued for a child care facility if~~ and has timely submitted all

17 of the screening materials ~~have been timely submitted~~. A
18 provisional license or registration may not be issued unless the
19 child care facility, family day care home, or large family child
20 care home is in compliance with the requirements for screening
21 of child care personnel in ss. 402.305, 402.3055, 402.313, and
22 402.3131, respectively.

23 (3) Notwithstanding subsection (2), the local licensing
24 agency or department, whichever is authorized to license child
25 care facilities in a county, must issue a provisional license or
26 registration if the operator or owner:

27 (a) Is applying for an initial license or registration for
28 a family day care home;

29 (b) Has made adequate provisions for the health and safety
30 of the child; and

31 (c) Provides evidence that he or she has completed, within
32 the previous 6 months, training pursuant to United States
33 Department of Defense Instruction 6060.02 and background
34 screening by the United States Department of Defense pursuant to
35 34 U.S.C. s. 20351 and 32 C.F.R. part 86 and received a
36 favorable fitness determination.

37 Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming law.
