| 15 | Section 1. Subsection (5) is added to section 295.22, |
| 16 | Florida Statutes, to read: |

| 18 | (5) PUBLIC RECORDS EXEMPTION Materials that relate to |
| 19 | methods of manufacture or production, potential trade secrets, |
| 20 | potentially patentable material, actual trade secrets, workforce |
| 21 | training plans, business transactions, business plans, military |
| 22 | records, skills assessments and career goals, resumes and |
| 23 | contact information, certificates, financial and proprietary |
| 24 | information, and agreements or proposals to receive funding |
| 25 | which are received, generated, ascertained, or discovered by |
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26 Florida Is For Veterans, Inc., including partnership and 27 training participants such as private enterprises, educational 28 institutions, and other organizations, for the purposes of 29 administering subsection (3) are confidential and exempt from s. 30 119.07(1) and s. 24(a), Art. I of the State Constitution. Aggregated data with no personal identifying information for 31 32 reporting purposes are not exempt. This subsection is subject to 33 the Open Government Sunset Review Act in accordance with s. 34 119.15 and shall stand repealed on October 2, 2028, unless 35 reviewed and saved from repeal through reenactment by the 36 Legislature. Section 2. The Legislature finds that it is a public 37 38 necessity that information pertaining to an individual or 39 organization that seeks assistance, services, or training under 40 s. 295.22(3), Florida Statutes, be made confidential and exempt 41 from public records requirements under s. 119.07(1), Florida 42 Statutes, and s. 24(a), Article I of the State Constitution. The 43 Legislature created the Veterans Employment and Training 44 Services Program and funds the program under s. 295.22(3), 45 Florida Statutes, administered by Florida Is For Veterans, Inc., in order to provide assistance, services, and training to 46 47 separating servicemembers, veterans, and others through 48 organizations including, but not limited to, employers, 49 nonprofit organizations, and universities in the areas of career 50 placement and training and entrepreneurship training to support
