Senate Joint Resolution

A joint resolution proposing the creation of Section 28 of Article I of the State Constitution to preserve in perpetuity hunting and fishing as a public right.

Be It Resolved by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

That the following creation of Section 28 of Article I of the State Constitution is agreed to and shall be submitted to the electors of this state for approval or rejection at the next general election or at an earlier special election specifically authorized by law for that purpose:

ARTICLE I

DECLARATION OF RIGHTS

SECTION 28. Hunting and fishing.—Hunting and fishing shall be preserved in perpetuity as a public right. This section does not limit the authority granted to the fish and wildlife conservation commission under Section 9 of Article IV and does not limit or restrict any law relating to trespass, property rights, or eminent domain.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the following statement be placed on the ballot:

CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT

ARTICLE I, SECTION 28

RIGHT TO HUNT, FISH, AND HARVEST WILDLIFE.—Proposing an amendment to the State Constitution to preserve in perpetuity hunting and fishing as a public right. Specifies that the amendment does not limit the authority granted to the Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission under Section 9 of Article IV
