23	home or building. When a new owner takes ownership of the home					
24	or building, the current timeframe for the existing manufacturer					
25	warranty for the HVAC system stays in place. A manufacturer					
26	warranty for an HVAC system automatically becomes effective upon					
27	the installation of the HVAC system. A contractor who installs a					
28	new HVAC system must document the installation through an					
29	invoice or receipt to the customer.
