7 (b) The commission may grant the petition, in whole or in
8 part, or with modifications in the public interest, or may deny
9 the petition if it finds the petition is not in the public
10 interest.

11 (c) The commission may not approve a rate base value
12 higher than that requested in the petition.

13 (5) Notwithstanding any provision in this section, the
14 commission may, pursuant to this chapter, set rates for the
15 acquired utility system in future rate cases and may classify

16 the acquired utility system as a separate entity for ratemaking
17 purposes if it is deemed to be in the public interest.

18 (6) This section applies to acquiring utilities that are
19 engaged in an arms-length acquisition of a water or wastewater
20 system, or both, and:

21 (a) Provide water or wastewater service, or both, to more
22 than 10,000 customers; or

23 (b) Are permitted to produce at least 3 million gallons
24 per day of drinking water.
