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Representative Abbott offered the following:

Amendment (with directory and title amendments)

Between lines 165 and 166, insert:

(2) LICENSES AND REGISTRATIONS; REQUIREMENTS, RENEWAL,
REVOCATION.-

(a) Except as provided in subsection (3), the owner or lessee of any airport in this state shall have either a public airport license or private airport registration prior to the operation of aircraft to or from the facility. Application for a license or registration shall be made in a form and manner prescribed by the department. Upon granting site approval:

1. For a public airport, the department shall issue a

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14 license after a final airport inspection finds the facility to
15 be in compliance with all requirements for the license. The
16 license may be subject to any reasonable conditions that the
17 department may deem necessary to protect the public health,
18 safety, or welfare.

19 2. For a private airport, the department shall provide
20 controlled electronic access to the state aviation facility data
21 system to permit the applicant to complete the registration
22 process. Registration shall be completed upon self-certification
23 by the registrant of operational and configuration data deemed
24 necessary by the department.

25 3. For an application for a public temporary airport or
26 private temporary airport site approval order, the department
27 must approve or deny the application within 30 days after
28 receipt of a complete application, notwithstanding the
29 requirements of s. 120.60. A complete airport site approval
30 application that is not approved or denied within 30 days after
31 the department receives the completed application is considered
32 approved, and the approval order shall be issued, subject to
33 such reasonable conditions as are authorized by law. Upon the
34 department's intent to approve or deny an applicant's temporary
35 private airport site approval order or temporary public airport
36 site approval order, the department must publish a notice of
37 intent to approve or deny the application in the next available
38 publication of the Florida Administrative Register. The notice

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39 must inform the recipient of any administrative hearing that is
40 available, indicate the procedure that must be followed to
41 obtain the hearing, and state that a request for hearing must be
42 submitted no later than 14 days after the date of publication.
43 The issuance of the site approval order will be held in abeyance
44 if a hearing is requested by a person whose substantial
45 interests will be determined or affected by the pending public
46 temporary airport or private temporary airport site approval
47 order. If site approval is granted, licensure of the public
48 temporary airport or registration of the private temporary
49 airport is deemed complete, and the department must issue the
50 public temporary airport license or private temporary airport
51 registration concurrent with the airport site approval. Any
52 applicant seeking to claim registration by default under this
53 subparagraph shall notify the agency clerk of the department, in
54 writing, of the intent to rely upon the default registration
55 provision of this subparagraph and may not take any action based
56 upon the default registration until after receipt of such notice
57 by the agency clerk.

82 requirements for an applicant seeking to claim
83 registration by default;

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
