Delete lines 83 - 101

and insert:

institution that is provided or authorized by the State  
Constitution and general law that all parental rights are  
reserved to the parent of a minor child without obstruction or  
interference from the state, any of its political subdivisions,  
any other governmental entity, or any other institution,  
including, but not limited to, the following rights of a parent

12 (a) The right to direct the education and care of his or  
13 her minor child.

14 (b) The right to direct the upbringing and moral or  
15 religious training of his or her minor child.

16 (2) An employee or a contractor of a public K-12  
17 educational institution shall address a student by the title and  
18 pronouns of the student's perceived sex unless the principal is
