An act relating to fees; amending s. 455.2135, F.S.;
authorizing applicable boards to charge a fee for
applications under the Interstate-Mobility and
Universal-Recognition Occupational Licensing Act;
providing a contingent effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Subsection (16) is added to section 455.2135,
Florida Statutes, as created by SB 1364 or similar legislation,
to read:

455.2135 Interstate-Mobility and Universal-Recognition
Occupational Licensing Act.—

(16) FEE.—A board may charge a fee to an applicant to
recoup the board's costs, not to exceed \$100 for each
application.

Section 2. This act shall take effect on the same date that
SB 1364 or similar legislation takes effect, if such legislation
is adopted in the same legislative session or an extension
thereof and becomes a law.
