17	person. This subsection does not apply to any act of medical
18	diagnosis, treatment, or prescription which is authorized under
19	the laws of this state.
20	(2) A person who violates subsection (1) commits a felony
21	of the third degree, punishable as provided in s. 775.082, s.
22	<u>775.083, or s. 775.084.</u>
23	Section 2. This act shall take effect October 1, 2023.
