7 382.021 Department to receive marriage licenses.—~~Weekly On~~  
 8 or before the 5th day of each month, the county court judge or  
 9 clerk of the circuit court shall electronically transmit all  
 10 original marriage licenses, with endorsements, received during  
 11 the preceding calendar week ~~month~~, to the department. Any  
 12 marriage licenses issued and not returned or any marriage  
 13 licenses returned but not recorded shall be reported by the  
 14 issuing county court judge or clerk of the circuit court to the  
 15 department at the time of transmitting the recorded licenses on  
 16 the forms to be prescribed and furnished by the department. If

17 during any month no marriage licenses are issued or returned,  
18 the county court judge or clerk of the circuit court shall  
19 report such fact to the department upon forms prescribed and  
20 furnished by the department.

21 Section 10. Section 382.023, Florida Statutes, is amended  
22 to read:

23 382.023 Department to receive dissolution-of-marriage  
24 records; fees.—Clerks of the circuit courts shall collect for  
25 their services at the time of the filing of a final judgment of  
26 dissolution of marriage a fee of up to \$10.50, of which 43  
27 percent shall be retained by the clerk of the circuit court as a  
28 part of the cost in the cause in which the judgment is granted.  
29 The remaining 57 percent shall be remitted to the Department of  
30 Revenue for deposit to the Department of Health to defray part  
31 of the cost of maintaining the dissolution-of-marriage records.  
32 A record of each and every judgment of dissolution of marriage  
33 granted by the court during the preceding calendar month, giving  
34 names of parties and such other data as required by forms  
35 prescribed by the department, shall be electronically  
36 transmitted to the department weekly, ~~on~~ or before the 10th day  
37 of each month, along with an accounting of the funds remitted to
