A bill to be entitled
An act relating to fees; amending s. 491.017, F.S.;
authorizing member states of the Professional
Counselors Licensure Compact to charge individuals a
fee for the privilege to practice under the compact;
providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Present subsections (3), (4), and (5) of Article
III of section 491.017, Florida Statutes, are redesignated as
subsections (4), (5), and (6), respectively, and a new
subsection (3) is added to Article III of that section, to read:

491.017 Professional Counselors Licensure Compact.—The
Professional Counselors Licensure Compact is hereby enacted and
entered into by this state with all other jurisdictions legally
joining therein in the form substantially as follows:

ARTICLE III

STATE PARTICIPATION

(3) A member state may charge a fee for granting the
privilege to practice.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2023.
