10 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

12           Section 1. Paragraph (i) of subsection (9) of section  
13           24.105, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

14           24.105 Powers and duties of department.—The department  
15           shall:

16           (9) Adopt rules governing the establishment and operation  
17           of the state lottery, including:

18           (i) The manner and amount of compensation of retailers,  
19           provided, however, that ~~except for the 2022-2023 fiscal year~~  
20           ~~only, effective July 1, 2022,~~ the commission for Florida Lottery  
21           ticket sales shall be 6 ~~5.75~~ percent of the purchase price of  
22           each ticket sold or issued as a prize by a retailer. ~~Any~~  
23           ~~additional retailer compensation is limited to the Florida~~  
24           ~~Lottery Retailer Bonus Commission program appropriated in~~  
25           ~~Specific Appropriation 2759U of the 2022-2023 General~~

27           Section 2. Effective upon this act becoming a law, section  
28           58 of chapter 2022-157, Laws of Florida, is repealed.
