



26        2. A defendant or a person may not use the resources of  
27 the courts of this state in furtherance of a defense or  
28 objection to postjudgment collection proceedings if the  
29 defendant or person purposely leaves the jurisdiction of this  
30 state or the United States, declines to enter or reenter this  
31 state or the United States to submit to its jurisdiction, or  
32 otherwise evades the jurisdiction of the court in which a  
33 criminal case is pending against the defendant or person. This  
34 subparagraph applies to any entity that is owned or controlled  
35 by a person to whom this paragraph applies.

36        (b) Paragraph (a) applies to any judgment collectible  
37 under state law and to any civil action pending or filed on or  
38 after the effective date of this act.

39        Section 2. The Division of Law Revision is directed to  
40 replace the phrase "the effective date of this act" wherever it  
41 appears in this act with the date this act becomes a law.

42        Section 3. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.
