16 (d) Reproductive health and disease education.—A public
17 school student whose parent makes written request to the school
18 principal shall be exempted from the teaching of reproductive
19 health or any disease, including HIV/AIDS, in accordance with s.
20 1003.42(5).

21 1. Each school district shall, on the district's website
22 homepage, notify parents of this right and the process to
23 request an exemption. The homepage must include a link for a
24 student's parent to access and review the instructional
25 materials, as defined in s. 1006.29(2), used to teach the
26 curriculum.

27 2. Each school district shall annually review and confirm
28 that the information provided on the district's website homepage
29 under subparagraph 1. is accurate and up to date and shall
30 notify parents by physical or electronic means any time
31 revisions are made to such information.
