16 (p) A student may possess and use a medication to relieve
17 headaches while on school property or at a school-sponsored
18 event or activity without a physician's note or prescription if
19 the medication is regulated by the United States Food and Drug
20 Administration for over-the-counter use to treat headaches.

21 Section 2. Subsection (10) is added to section 1006.09,
22 Florida Statutes, to read:

23 1006.09 Duties of school principal relating to student
24 discipline and school safety.—

25 (10) Any search of a student's personal belongings,
26 including a purse, backpack, or bookbag, must be conducted
27 discreetly to maintain the privacy of the student's personal
28 items within such belongings. Personal items that are not
29 prohibited on school grounds must be immediately returned to the
30 student's personal belongings.
