6 Remove lines 16-28 and insert:

7 (1) As used in this section, the term:

8 (a) "Harass" means to engage in a course of conduct
9 directed at a law enforcement officer which causes substantial
10 emotional distress to that law enforcement officer and serves to
11 legitimate purpose.

12 (b) "Law enforcement officer" has the same meaning as in
13 s. 943.10(1).

14 (2) It is unlawful for a person, after receiving a warning
15 not to approach from a law enforcement officer who is engaged in
16 the lawful performance of a legal duty, to violate such warning

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17 and approach or remain within 20 feet of the law enforcement
18 officer with the intent to:

19 1. Interrupt, disrupt, hinder, impede, or interfere with
20 the law enforcement officer's ability to perform such duty;

21 2. Threaten the law enforcement officer with physical
22 harm; or

23 3. Harass the law enforcement officer or make so much
24 noise that the law enforcement officer is prevented from
25 performing his or her official duties.
