Delete everything after the enacting clause
and insert:

Section 1. Paragraph (a) of subsection (2) of section
163.211, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

163.211 Licensing of occupations preempted to state.—

(2) PREEMPTION OF OCCUPATIONAL LICENSING TO THE STATE.—The
licensing of occupations is expressly preempted to the state,
and this section supersedes any local government licensing

12 (a) Any local government that imposed licenses on
13 occupations before January 1, 2021. However, any such local
