annual renewal fee may exceed \$500.

27 <u>(4)(3)</u> The department shall provide to each dog breeder 28 subject to this section a written notice and renewal form 60 29 days before the annual renewal date, informing the dog breeder 30 of the certificate of registration renewal date <u>and the</u> 31 applicable fee.

32 <u>(5)(4)</u> The department may assess penalties for late 33 filing, not to exceed \$500. Upon application before the renewal 34 date, the department may, for good cause, such as natural 35 disasters, hardship cases, or unusual circumstances, supported 36 by written documentation, extend the renewal date without 37 penalty for up to 90 days.

38 <u>(6)(5)</u> The department shall issue a certificate of 39 inspection to any dog breeding facility that meets the 40 requirements of this part and the rules of the department.

41 <u>(7)(6)</u> Each dog breeder and dog breeding facility must 42 conspicuously post its certificates of registration and 43 inspection in a place that is in clear and unobstructed public 44 view.

45 Section 2. This act shall take effect on the same date 46 that HB 1581 or similar legislation takes effect, if such 47 legislation is adopted in the same legislative session or an 48 extension thereof and becomes a law.
