5 Remove everything after the enacting clause and insert:
 6 Section 1. Section 252.3712, Florida Statutes, is created to
 7 read:

8 252.3712 Nonprofit Security Grant Program.—

9 (1) The division shall establish a Nonprofit Security
 10 Grant Program which shall consist of funds appropriated by the
 11 Legislature to nonprofit organizations, including houses of
 12 worship and community centers, that are at high risk for violent
 13 attacks or hate crimes. The grants may be used to increase
 14 security and safety, including, but not limited to:

15 (a) The purchase and installation of security
 16 infrastructure, perimeter lighting, door hardening, security

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17 camera systems, perimeter fencing, barriers and bollards, blast
18 resistant film and shatter resistant glass for windows.

19 (b) Hiring security personnel.

20 (c) Training for security personnel and staff on threat
21 awareness, emergency procedures, and first aid.

22 (2) The minimum amount of any grant award is \$10,000, and
23 the maximum grant award amount is \$150,000. The total amount of
24 funds available for the program is limited to the amount
25 appropriated by the Legislature.

26 (3) The division may use up to 3 percent of the total
27 amount appropriated to administer the grant program.

28 (4) The division shall adopt rules to administer this
29 section.

30 (5) This section expires January 1, 2028, unless reviewed
31 and saved from repeal through reenactment by the Legislature.

32 Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2023.
