17	endemic to the State of Florida, NOW, THEREFORE,

19	Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

21	Section 1. Section 15.0352, Florida Statutes, is created

23	15.0352 Official state bird.—The Florida scrub-jay
24	(Aphelocoma coerulescens) is designated as the official Florida
