(1) (a) Except as provided in subsections (3), (4), and (5), a person, other than a health care provider, an emergency responder licensed in the United States, a hospital staff member, a public or private commercial transportation provider, a family member, an attorney licensed to practice law in the this state or to practice before a federal court in the United States, a public or private school official, a charity nonprofit service provider, or a faith based service provider, who knowingly and willfully ~~a person who~~ transports into this state

28 4. Asylees and asylum seekers.

29 5. Persons with a valid parole document from the United  
30 States Citizenship and Immigration Service.

31 6. Persons in possession of T Nonimmigrant Status ("T-  
32 Visa"), U Nonimmigrant Status ("U-Visa"), or protected under the  
33 immigration provisions of the Violence Against Women Act (VAWA)  
34 or who have a pending petition for a T-Visa, U-Visa, or  
35 protection under the VAWA.

36 7. Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals (DACA)  
37 recipients or persons with pending applications for DACA.
