Remove lines 15-67 and insert:

Section 1. Section 500.92, Florida Statutes, is created to read:

500.92 Florida Kratom Consumer Protection Act.-

(1) This section may be cited as the "Florida Kratom Consumer Protection Act."

(2) As used in this section, the term "kratom product" means a food product, food ingredient, dietary ingredient, dietary supplement, or beverage intended for human consumption which contains any part of the leaf of the plant *Mitragyna speciosa* or an extract, synthetic alkaloid, or synthetically

17 derived compound of such plant and is manufactured as a powder,  
18 capsule, pill, beverage, or other edible form.

19 (3) It is unlawful to sell, deliver, barter, furnish, or  
20 give, directly or indirectly, to any person who is under 21  
21 years of age, any kratom product.

22 (4) Any retail food store, food establishment, or cottage  
23 food operation who violates subsection (3) is subject to an  
24 administrative fine of not more than \$100 for the first offense,  
25 not more than \$500 for the second offense, and not more than  
26 \$1,000 for the third or subsequent offense.

27 (5) The department shall adopt rules to administer this
