Section 2. The statute of repose imposed by this act applies to any action commenced on or after the effective date of this act, except that any action that would not have been barred before the imposition of the statute of repose but would become barred by its imposition must be commenced on or before July 1, 2024. If such action is not commenced by July 1, 2024, then the action is barred.

Section 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2023.
