7 (d) An individual charter school student pursuant to s.  
 8 1002.33 is eligible to participate at the public school to which  
 9 the student would be assigned according to district school board  
 10 attendance area policies or which the student could attend, or  
 11 may develop an agreement to participate at a private school, in  
 12 any interscholastic extracurricular activity of that school,  
 13 unless such activity is provided by the student's charter  
 14 school, if the following conditions are met:

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15           1. The charter school student must meet the requirements  
16 of the charter school education program as determined by the  
17 charter school governing board.

18           2. During the period of participation at a school, the  
19 charter school student must demonstrate educational progress as  
20 required in paragraph (b).

21           3. The charter school student must meet the same residency  
22 requirements as other students in the school at which he or she  
23 participates.

24           4. The charter school student must meet the same standards  
25 of acceptance, behavior, and performance that are required of  
26 other students in extracurricular activities.

27           5. The charter school student must register with the  
28 school his or her intent to participate in interscholastic  
29 extracurricular activities as a representative of the school  
30 before participation. A charter school student must be able to  
31 participate in curricular activities if that is a requirement  
32 for an extracurricular activity.

33           6. A student who transfers from a charter school program  
34 to a traditional public school before or during the first  
35 grading period of the school year is academically eligible to  
36 participate in interscholastic extracurricular activities during  
37 the first grading period if the student has a successful  
38 evaluation from the previous school year, pursuant to  
39 subparagraph 2.

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40 7. Any public school or private school student who has  
41 been unable to maintain academic eligibility for participation  
42 in interscholastic extracurricular activities is ineligible to  
43 participate in such activities as a charter school student until  
44 the student has successfully completed one grading period in a  
45 charter school pursuant to subparagraph 2. to become eligible to  
46 participate as a charter school student.

47 (e) A student of the Florida Virtual School full-time  
48 program may participate in any interscholastic extracurricular  
49 activity at any the public school in the school district in  
50 which the student resides to which the student would be assigned  
51 according to district school board attendance area policies or  
52 which the student could choose to attend pursuant to s. 1002.31,  
53 or may develop an agreement to participate at a private school,
