Following Specific Appropriation 118, DELETE:

From the funds in Specific Appropriation 118, \$2,547,500 in recurring funds and \$12,540,975 in nonrecurring funds from the General Revenue Fund are provided for the new Adult General Education Performance-Based Incentive Funds.
