- (1) For the purposes of this section, the term "gender clinical interventions" means surgical procedures that alter internal or external physical traits for the purpose of affirming a person's perception of his or her sex if that perception is inconsistent with the person's sex at birth.
- (a) The term includes, but is not limited to, sex reassignment surgeries or any other surgical procedures that alter primary or secondary sexual characteristics.
 - (b) The term does not include:

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1. Treatment provided by a physician who, in his or her	=
good faith clinical judgment, performs procedures upon, or	
provides therapies to, a minor born with a medically verifiab	le
genetic disorder of sexual development, including the followi	ng:

- <u>a. External biological sex characteristics that are</u> unresolvably ambiguous.
- b. A disorder of sexual development, in which the physician has determined through genetic or biochemical testing that the minor does not have normal sex chromosome structure, sex steroid hormone production, or sex steroid hormone action for a male or female.
- 2. Treatment of any infection, injury, disease, or disorder caused or exacerbated by the performance of gender clinical interventions regardless of whether such interventions were performed in accordance with state or federal law.
- 3. Puberty blocking, hormone, and hormone antagonistic therapies.
