Remove lines 2-51 and insert:

An act relating to medical treatments and procedures; amending s. 61.517, F.S.; granting courts of this state temporary emergency jurisdiction over a child present in this state if the child has been subjected to or is threatened with being subjected to sex-reassignment prescriptions or procedures; amending s. 61.534, F.S.; providing that, for purposes of warrants to take physical custody of a child in certain child custody enforcement proceedings, serious physical harm to the child includes, but is not limited to, being subjected to sex-reassignment prescriptions or procedures; creating s. 286.31, F.S.; defining the term "governmental entity"; prohibiting certain public entities from expending state funds for the provision of sex-reassignment prescriptions or procedures; amending s. 395.003, F.S.; requiring certain licensed facilities, by a specified date and as a condition of licensure thereafter, to provide a signed attestation of specified information to the Agency for Health Care Administration; requiring the agency to revoke a facility's license for failure to provide such attestation, subject to the due process procedures of ch. 120, F.S.; amending s. 456.001, F.S.; defining the terms "sex" and "sex-reassignment prescriptions or procedures"; creating s. 456.52, F.S.; prohibiting sex-
