Between lines 225 and 226, insert:

(e) Two physicians certify in writing that, in reasonable medical judgment, the termination of the pregnancy is necessary because the pregnant woman is experiencing a preterm premature medical condition, including, but not limited to, preterm premature rupture of the membranes (PPROM); a bleeding disorder; anemia; Stage 4 or 5 Chronic Kidney Disease or acute renal failure; progressively worsening renal disease; maternal cancer and is unable to receive optimal treatment in pregnancy; previable HELLP syndrome; previable preeclampsia with severe

14 features; previable chorioamnionitis; evidence of critical
15 illness, including sepsis and end-stage organ damage; life
16 threatening acute pregnant woman's hemorrhage; cystic fibrosis

19 caused by a fatal fetal abnormality; or any medical condition
20 that causes a serious risk of death to or a serious risk of
21 substantial and irreversible physical impairment of a major
22 bodily function of the pregnant woman. One physician may certify
23 if another physician is not available for consultation.
