Amendment (with directory and title amendments)

Between lines 250 and 251, insert:

(16) CHILD SUPPORT.—If a woman who seeks abortion care is denied such care because she is beyond the 6 week timeframe, she must receive documentation that states she is beyond the timeframe to receive abortion care. Once she receives such documentation, she may petition the court for an order of child support. Upon petition to the court, the order shall be entered automatically.

(a) The order shall be entered and the child support shall be at least \$350 per month to cover prenatal care. The money

14 shall be deposited in a depository account with the clerk of
15 courts pending the verification of a DNA test of paternal
16 parentage. This test can be done prenatal or post birth. Once
17 paternity is confirmed, the court shall enter an order based
18 upon the child support calculation methods already set in
19 general law.

20 (b) The order shall include financial support for 3 months
21 post birth. The court shall require financial support of the
22 child while the mother recovers on maternity leave. The mother
23 must submit at least 3 months of pay stubs to the court for an
24 order to be entered to provide up to 50 percent of her income to
25 the mother for support during maternity leave.

26 (c) Timesharing for the child may begin 1 year after the
27 date the child is born upon a petition to the court or any time
28 thereafter upon a petition to the court.
