(e) The following state officers must comply with the financial disclosure requirements of s. 8, Art. II of the State Constitution and this section:

1. Each appointed member of each board, commission, authority, or council having statewide jurisdiction, excluding a member of an advisory body.

2. Each member of the Board of Governors of the State University System or a state university board of trustees, the Chancellor and Vice Chancellors of the State University System, and the president of a state university.

20 1. The State Surgeon General and each appointed secretary,
