18	the department. The word "Florida" must appear at the top of the
19	plate, and the words "United Service Organizations" must appear
20	at the bottom of the plate.
21	(b) The annual use fees from the sale of the plate must be
22	distributed to United Service Organizations, a nonprofit
23	corporation under s. 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code,
24	which may use up to 10 percent of such fees for administrative
25	costs and marketing of the plate. The balance of the fees shall
26	be used by United Service Organizations for the organization's
27	operations, activities, programs, or projects.
28	Section 2. This act shall take effect October 1, 2023.
