Maintain a sink in compliance with Department of 31 32 Business and Professional Regulation standards. 33 6. Maintain either internal or external fresh water supply 34 and gray water disposal. 35 7. Maintain electrical, plumbing, and mechanical specifications that meet or exceed national agency standards or 36 37 best industry standards. 38 8. Maintain a wind rating greater than 70 mph.
