Remove lines 767-804 and insert:

ineligibility by mail, telephone, or e-mail within 7 days after receipt of notice or information. The notice must ~~shall~~ include:

- a. A statement of the basis for the registered voter's potential ineligibility and a copy of any documentation upon which the potential ineligibility is based. If the voter is reached by telephone, the supervisor must inform the voter of such documentation and offer to provide the documentation by mail or email. Such documentation must include any conviction from another jurisdiction determined to be a similar offense to

14 murder or a felony sexual offense, as those terms are defined in
15 s. 98.0751.

16 b. A statement that failure to respond within 30 days
17 after receipt of the notice may result in a determination of
18 ineligibility and in removal of the registered voter's name from
19 the statewide voter registration system.

20 c. A return form that requires the registered voter to
21 admit or deny the accuracy of the information underlying the
22 potential ineligibility for purposes of a final determination by
23 the supervisor. If the voter is reached by telephone, the
24 supervisor must offer to provide the voter with the form by mail
25 or email.

26 d. A statement that, if the voter is denying the accuracy
27 of the information underlying the potential ineligibility, the
28 voter has a right to request a hearing for the purpose of
29 determining eligibility.

30 e. Instructions for the registered voter to contact the
31 supervisor of elections of the county in which the voter is
32 registered if assistance is needed in resolving the matter.

33 f. Instructions for seeking restoration of civil rights
34 pursuant to s. 8, Art. IV of the State Constitution and
35 information explaining voting rights restoration pursuant to s.
36 4, Art. VI of the State Constitution following a felony
37 conviction, if applicable.

38 g. The following statement: "If you attempt to vote at an
39 early voting site or your normal election day polling place, you
40 will be required to vote a provisional ballot. If you vote by
41 mail, your ballot will be treated as a provisional ballot. In
42 either case, your ballot may not be counted until a final
43 determination of eligibility is made. If you wish for your
44 ballot to be counted, you must contact the supervisor of
45 elections office within 2 days after the election and present
46 evidence that you are eligible to vote."
