7 787.06 Human trafficking.—

8 (7) Any real property or personal property that was used,
9 attempted to be used, or intended to be used in violation of ~~any~~
10 ~~provision of~~ this section may be seized and shall be forfeited
11 as provided by subject to the provisions of the Florida
12 Contraband Forfeiture Act. After satisfying any liens on the
13 property, the remaining proceeds from the sale of any property

14 seized under this section and owned by a defendant convicted of
15 a violation of this section must first be allocated to pay any
16 order of restitution of a human trafficking victim in the
17 criminal case for which the owner was convicted. If there are

19 remaining proceeds must be allocated equally among the victims
20 to pay restitution. If the proceeds are sufficient to pay any
21 such order of restitution, any remaining proceeds must be
22 disbursed as required by s. 932.7055(5)-(9).
