## Amendment (with title amendment)

Remove everything after the enacting clause and insert:

8 Section 1. Present paragraph (d) of subsection (1) of 9 section 320.08, Florida Statutes, is redesignated as paragraph 10 (g), a new paragraph (d) and paragraphs (e) and (f) are added to 11 that subsection, and paragraph (c) of that subsection is 12 amended, to read:

13 320.08 License taxes.-Except as otherwise provided herein, 14 there are hereby levied and imposed annual license taxes for the 15 operation of motor vehicles, mopeds, tri-vehicles as defined in 16 s. 316.003, and mobile homes as defined in s. 320.01, which 694269 - h0709-strike.docx

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17 shall be paid to and collected by the department or its agent 18 upon the registration or renewal of registration of the 19 following:

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(1) MOTORCYCLES AND MOPEDS.-

Upon registration of a motorcycle, motor-driven cycle, 21 (C) 22 or moped, in addition to the license taxes specified in this 23 subsection, a nonrefundable motorcycle safety education fee in 24 the amount of \$2.50 shall be paid. The proceeds of the safety 25 education such additional fee shall be deposited in the Highway 26 Safety Operating Trust Fund to fund a motorcycle driver 27 improvement program implemented pursuant to s. 322.025, the 28 Florida Motorcycle Safety Education Program established in s. 29 322.0255, or the general operations of the department.

30 (d) The entire safety education fee shall be used for a 31 safety and education program administered by a Florida not-for-32 profit corporation. The program administrator must:

33 <u>1. Be a charity registered with the Department of</u> 34 <u>Agriculture and Consumer Services;</u>

35 <u>2. Have a history of actively advocating for motorcycle</u>
36 <u>safety and education in this state for at least 30 years;</u>
37 3. Be a motorcycle grassroots organization that has

38 <u>actively worked with the Florida motorcycle community for at</u> 39 least 30 years;

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42	5. Have at least 3,000 active members drawn from the

44	(e) The department shall enter into a 5-year contract with
45	the program administrator to use the safety education fee to pay
46	for motorcycle safety and education programs. The programs must
47	promote motorcycle safety and education for the purpose of
48	reducing motorcycle injuries and deaths in this state. The
49	programs may include pamphlets, advertisements, public service
50	announcements, digital media, social media, a website,
51	participation at grassroots motorcycle events, advocacy, and
52	reasonable administrative expenses.
53	(f) The program administrator shall file an annual report

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66 The owner of a motor vehicle for private use (1)manufactured in model year 1945 or earlier and operated on the 67 68 streets and highways of this state shall, upon application in 69 the manner and at the time prescribed by the department and upon 70 payment of the license tax for an ancient motor vehicle 71 prescribed by s. 320.08(1)(g), (2)(a), or (3)(e) s. 72 320.08(1)(d), (2)(a), or (3)(e), be issued a special license 73 plate for such motor vehicle. The license plate shall be 74 permanent and valid for use without renewal so long as the 75 vehicle is in existence. In addition to the payment of all other 76 fees required by law, the applicant shall pay such fee for the 77 issuance of the special license plate as may be prescribed by 78 the department commensurate with the cost of its manufacture. 79 The registration numbers and special license plates assigned to 80 such motor vehicles shall run in a separate numerical series, 81 commencing with "Horseless Carriage No. 1," and the plates shall 82 be of a distinguishing color.

The owner of a motor vehicle for private use 83 (2)(a) 84 manufactured in a model year after 1945 and of the age of 30 85 years or more after the model year and operated on the streets and highways of this state may, upon application in the manner 86 and at the time prescribed by the department and upon payment of 87 88 the license tax prescribed by s. 320.08(1)(q), (2)(a), or (3)(e)89 s. 320.08(1)(d), (2)(a), or (3)(e), be issued a special license 90 plate for such motor vehicle. 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91 other fees required by law, the applicant shall pay the fee for 92 the issuance of the special license plate prescribed by the 93 department, commensurate with the cost of its manufacture. The 94 registration numbers and special license plates assigned to such 95 motor vehicles shall run in a separate numerical series, 96 commencing with "Antique No. 1," and the plates shall be of a 97 distinguishing color. The owner of the motor vehicle may, upon application and payment of the license tax prescribed by s. 98 99 320.08, be issued a regular Florida license plate or specialty 100 license plate in lieu of the special "Antique" license plate. By October 1, 2023, the Department of Highway 101 Section 3. 102 Safety and Motor Vehicles shall select a qualified program administrator and enter into the contract as specified in this 103 104 act. The department shall transmit the safety education fee 105 quarterly to the administrator, with the first payment being

106 payable October 1, 2023.

Section 4. This act shall take effect July 1, 2023.
