 8 and regulations for the use of explosives in
 9 connection with such construction materials mining
 10 activities; providing an effective date.

 12 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

 14 Section 1. Subsection (4) is added to section 552.30,
 15 Florida Statutes, to read:

16 552.30 Construction materials mining activities.—

17 (4)(a) Beginning July 1, 2023, and notwithstanding any
 18 other law, rule, or ordinance, the ground vibration limit for
 19 construction materials mining activities within 1 mile of
 20 residentially zoned areas may not exceed .15 inches per second.

21 (b) Notwithstanding this section or any other law, the
 22 Chief Financial Officer may direct the State Fire Marshal to
 23 modify the standards, limits, and regulations for the use of
 24 explosives in connection with construction materials mining
 25 activities within 1 mile of residentially zoned areas,
