6 prescribe and dispense an emergency opioid antagonist to, and a  
7 pharmacist may order an emergency opioid antagonist with an  
8 autoinjection delivery system, prefilled injection device  
9 delivery system, or intranasal application delivery system for,  
10 a patient or caregiver for use in accordance with this section.

11 (b) A pharmacist may dispense an emergency opioid  
12 antagonist pursuant to a prescription by an authorized health  
13 care practitioner. A pharmacist may dispense an emergency opioid

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14 antagonist with an autoinjection delivery system, prefilled  
15 injection device delivery system, or intranasal application  
16 delivery system, which must be appropriately labeled with  
17 instructions for use, pursuant to a pharmacist's order or  
18 pursuant to a nonpatient-specific standing order.
