1 House Resolution 2 A resolution recognizing March 8, 2023, as 3 "International Women's Day" in Florida. 4 5 WHEREAS, International Women's Day is an annual celebration 6 of women's cultural, educational, economic, political, and 7 social accomplishments, and recognizes the achievements of women, regardless of their cultural, economic, ethnic, 8 9 linguistic, national, or political divisions, and WHEREAS, on February 28, 1909, the first national Women's 10 11 Day was observed in the United States, and WHEREAS, on June 26, 1945, the Charter of the United 12 Nations was signed, marking the first affirmation of equality 13 14 between women and men by international agreement, and WHEREAS, the United Nations celebrated International 15 16 Women's Day for the first time on March 8, 1975, and 2 years later, declared a day for international peace and women's rights 17 18 by resolution in the United Nations General Assembly, and 19 WHEREAS, every year, approximately 12 million girls 20 worldwide are married before they reach the age of 18, and 21 WHEREAS, according to the International Labour Organization, 71 percent of the estimated 40 million victims of 22 23 modern slavery in 2016 were women and girls, and

24 WHEREAS, according to the World Health Organization, an 25 estimated one out of three women around the world has 26 experienced some form of physical or sexual violence, and 27 WHEREAS, women also occupy statewide leadership positions 28 including Lieutenant Governor, Attorney General, and Senate 29 President, and 30 WHEREAS, currently, approximately 41 percent of the members of the Florida Legislature are women, including 50 31 32 representatives and 16 senators, and WHEREAS, in continuing the tradition of honoring Florida 33 34 women, Virginia Covington, Barbara B. Nicklaus, and Beverly Yeager were added to the Florida Women's Hall of Fame for making 35 36 significant contributions in the life of women and residents of 37 Florida, and WHEREAS, fifty-eight percent of women are active in the 38 39 workforce, with teachers; nurses; and nursing, psychiatric, and 40 home health aides comprising the top three most popular career 41 occupations for women, and 42 WHEREAS, the theme of International Women's Day 2023 is 43 "Embrace Equity," NOW, THEREFORE, 44 Be It Resolved by the House of Representatives of the State of 45 46 Florida: 47
