WHEREAS, Cuba comprises an archipelago of nearly 1,600 islands, islets, and cays, with a combined area three-fourths as

WHEREAS, Cuba was claimed by Christopher Columbus for Spain in 1492, displacing aboriginal tribes such as the Guanahatabey, Ciboney, and Taíno who inhabited the island, and

WHEREAS, Cuba became the Spanish Empire's most important source of raw sugar in the 18th century and later earned the nickname "Pearl of the Antilles," and

WHEREAS, Spain retained rule of Cuba until 1898, when it was defeated by the United States and Cuban forces in the Spanish-American War, and

WHEREAS, during the Spanish-American War, Florida served as the base of operations for the Cuban exile community, following in the footsteps of renowned Cuban author, philosopher, and journalist José Martí whose patriotic writing envisioning a free Cuba inspired the next generation of freedom fighters, and

WHEREAS, after Cuba achieved independence from Spain, the culture, politics, and economies of the United States and Cuba became closely intertwined, and

WHEREAS, more than one million Cubans have fled to the United States since 1959, many of whom have established their lives in Florida, and

WHEREAS, presently, Cuban immigrants comprise approximately 23 percent of the population of Florida, making Cubans the largest group of immigrants to Florida, and

WHEREAS, acclaimed Cuban-Americans include economist George J. Borjas; businessman and advocate for democracy and freedom the late Jorge Mas Canosa; Olympic gymnast Annia Portuondo Hatch; Emmy-winning actor Oscar Nuñez; Grammy-winning singer Armando Christian Peréz who is otherwise known as "Pitbull"; celebrity chef and global restauranteur the late Carl Albert Ruiz; singer, songwriter, actress, and businesswoman Gloria Estefan; singer the late Celia Cruz who is known as the "Queen of Salsa Music"; Central Intelligence Officer Félix Rodríguez who earned the rare Intelligence Star of Valor; United States Senators Marco Antonio Rubio and Melquiades "Mel" Rafael Ruiz Martínez; and Governor Robert "Bob" Martinez who is the first person of Spanish descent to be elected Governor of Florida, and

WHEREAS, Cuba's roots and influence remain strong today, with various aspects of Cuban culture present in the everyday lives of Floridians, NOW, THEREFORE,
