 8 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

 10 Section 1. Section 14 is added to section 2 of chapter 99-
 11 478, Laws of Florida, as amended by chapter 2001-315, Laws of
 12 Florida, to read:

13 Section 14. Annexation of territories by municipalities.-

14 (1) For the purposes and requirements of this act, after
 15 the annexation by a municipality of any unincorporated area
 16 within the district, the annexed area shall be treated as lying
 17 within the corporate boundaries of the annexing municipality and
 18 shall not be subject to a levy of the ad valorem tax that is
 19 authorized by this act.

20 (2) Notwithstanding s. 171.093, Florida Statutes, if a
 21 municipality annexes any unincorporated territory situated
 22 within the defined boundaries of the district after the
 23 effective date of this act, the municipality may levy any
 24 applicable taxes, assessments, or fees on the annexed territory
 25 but must, by May 1 of each subsequent year after such

26 annexation, pay the district for its services in an amount equal
27 to the amount of taxes, assessments, or fees which would have
28 been collected by the district from the annexed territory during
29 that year had the territory not been annexed, using the millage
30 rate in effect on the effective date of this act, or any lower
31 rate that may be levied by the district. Such payments shall
32 continue for 10 years. If litigation is required to enforce the
33 provisions of this act, the prevailing party shall be entitled
34 to an award of attorney fees and costs.

35 Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.
