16 (1) The owner of a motor vehicle for private use  
17 manufactured in model year 1945 or earlier and operated on the  
18 streets and highways of this state shall, upon application in  
19 the manner and at the time prescribed by the department and upon  
20 payment of the license tax for an ancient motor vehicle  
21 prescribed by s. 320.08(1)(h), (2)(a), or (3)(e) ~~s.~~  
22 ~~320.08(1)(d), (2)(a), or (3)(e)~~, be issued a special license  
23 plate for such motor vehicle. The license plate shall be  
24 permanent and valid for use without renewal so long as the  
25 vehicle is in existence. In addition to the payment of all other  
26 fees required by law, the applicant shall pay such fee for the  
27 issuance of the special license plate as may be prescribed by  
28 the department commensurate with the cost of its manufacture.  
29 The registration numbers and special license plates assigned to  
30 such motor vehicles shall run in a separate numerical series,  
31 commencing with "Horseless Carriage No. 1," and the plates shall  
32 be of a distinguishing color.
