7 (1) A person employed or appointed as a chief of police
8 may not be terminated by the employing agency without being
9 provided written notice.

10 (2) If the membership of the governing body of the
11 employing agency is composed of elected officials, a chief of
12 police whose employment was terminated as provided in subsection
13 (1) shall be placed on the agenda of the next regularly
14 scheduled public meeting of the governing body and shall be
15 allowed to make a full and complete response to the written
16 notice of termination.

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17 (3) The requirements of this section are not superseded by
18 any written employment contract or agreement that provides
19 employment, discipline, or termination standards or procedures,
20 including any agreement of non-disclosure.
