 2 An act relating to driver license, identification  
 3 card, and motor vehicle registration applications;  
 4 amending ss. 320.02 and 322.08, F.S.; requiring that  
 5 the motor vehicle registration form and registration  
 6 renewal form and the driver license or identification  
 7 card application form, respectively, include an option  
 8 to make a voluntary contribution to Best Buddies  
 9 International; providing an effective date.

 11 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

 13 Section 1. Paragraph (v) is added to subsection (16) of  
 14 section 320.02, Florida Statutes, to read:

15 320.02 Registration required; application for  
 16 registration; forms.—

18 (v) The application form for motor vehicle registration  
 19 and renewal of registration must include language permitting a  
 20 voluntary contribution of \$1 to Best Buddies International. Such  
 21 contributions shall be distributed monthly by the department to  
 22 Best Buddies International, a corporation not for profit under  
 23 s. 501(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

 25 For the purpose of applying the service charge provided in s.

26 | 215.20, contributions received under this subsection are not  
27 | income of a revenue nature.

28 | Section 2. Subsection (8) of section 322.08, Florida  
29 | Statutes, is amended to read:

30 | 322.08 Application for license; requirements for license  
31 | and identification card forms.—

32 | (8) The application form for an original, renewal, or  
33 | replacement driver license or identification card must include  
34 | language permitting the following:

35 | (a) A voluntary contribution of \$1 per applicant, which  
36 | contribution shall be deposited into the Health Care Trust Fund  
37 | for organ and tissue donor education and for maintaining the  
38 | organ and tissue donor registry.

39 | (b) A voluntary contribution of \$1 per applicant, which  
40 | shall be distributed to the Florida Council of the Blind.

41 | (c) A voluntary contribution of \$2 per applicant, which  
42 | shall be distributed to the Hearing Research Institute,  
43 | Incorporated.

44 | (d) A voluntary contribution of \$1 per applicant, which  
45 | shall be distributed to the Juvenile Diabetes Foundation  
46 | International.

47 | (e) A voluntary contribution of \$1 per applicant, which  
48 | shall be distributed to the Children's Hearing Help Fund.

49 | (f) A voluntary contribution of \$1 per applicant, which  
50 | shall be distributed to Family First, a nonprofit organization.

51 (g) A voluntary contribution of \$1 per applicant to Stop  
52 Heart Disease, which shall be distributed to the Florida Heart  
53 Research Institute, a nonprofit organization.

54 (h) A voluntary contribution of \$1 per applicant to Senior  
55 Vision Services, which shall be distributed to the Florida  
56 Association of Agencies Serving the Blind, Inc., a not-for-  
57 profit organization.

58 (i) A voluntary contribution of \$1 per applicant for  
59 services for persons with developmental disabilities, which  
60 shall be distributed to The Arc of Florida.

61 (j) A voluntary contribution of \$1 to the Ronald McDonald  
62 House, which shall be distributed each month to Ronald McDonald  
63 House Charities of Tampa Bay, Inc.

64 (k) Notwithstanding s. 322.081, a voluntary contribution  
65 of \$1 per applicant, which shall be distributed to the League  
66 Against Cancer/La Liga Contra el Cancer, a not-for-profit  
67 organization.

68 (l) A voluntary contribution of \$1 per applicant to  
69 Prevent Child Sexual Abuse, which shall be distributed to  
70 Lauren's Kids, Inc., a nonprofit organization.

71 (m) A voluntary contribution of \$1 per applicant, which  
72 shall be distributed to Prevent Blindness Florida, a not-for-  
73 profit organization, to prevent blindness and preserve the sight  
74 of the residents of this state.

75 (n) Notwithstanding s. 322.081, a voluntary contribution

76 of \$1 per applicant to the state homes for veterans, to be  
77 distributed on a quarterly basis by the department to the  
78 Operations and Maintenance Trust Fund within the Department of  
79 Veterans' Affairs.

80 (o) A voluntary contribution of \$1 per applicant to the  
81 Disabled American Veterans, Department of Florida, which shall  
82 be distributed quarterly to Disabled American Veterans,  
83 Department of Florida, a nonprofit organization.

84 (p) A voluntary contribution of \$1 per applicant for  
85 Autism Services and Supports, which shall be distributed to  
86 Achievement and Rehabilitation Centers, Inc., Autism Services  
87 Fund.

88 (q) A voluntary contribution of \$1 per applicant to  
89 Support Our Troops, which shall be distributed to Support Our  
90 Troops, Inc., a Florida not-for-profit organization.

91 (r) Notwithstanding s. 322.081, a voluntary contribution  
92 of \$1 per applicant to aid the homeless. Contributions made  
93 pursuant to this paragraph shall be deposited into the Grants  
94 and Donations Trust Fund of the Department of Children and  
95 Families and used by the State Office on Homelessness to  
96 supplement grants made under s. 420.622(4) and (5), provide  
97 information to the public about homelessness in the state, and  
98 provide literature for homeless persons seeking assistance.

99 (s) A voluntary contribution of \$1 or more per applicant  
100 to End Breast Cancer, which shall be distributed to the Florida

101 Breast Cancer Foundation.

102 (t) Notwithstanding s. 322.081(1), a voluntary  
103 contribution of \$1 or more per applicant to Childhood Cancer  
104 Care, which shall be distributed to the Live Like Bella  
105 Childhood Cancer Foundation.

106 (u) A voluntary contribution of \$1 or more per applicant  
107 to Best Buddies International, which shall be distributed  
108 monthly to Best Buddies International, a corporation not for  
109 profit under s. 501(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

110  
111 A statement providing an explanation of the purpose of the trust  
112 funds shall also be included. For the purpose of applying the  
113 service charge provided under s. 215.20, contributions received  
114 under paragraphs (b)-(u) ~~(b)-(t)~~ are not income of a revenue  
115 nature.

116 Section 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2023.
